PROTOCOLS TO FOLLOW

GUIDELINES TO PARENTS

- Profile form: The students profile form printed in the school almanac should be filled in correctly and promptly.
- Attendance: Parents are expected to ensure that their child attends school regularly and on time, and to communicate with the school if their child is absent.
- 3. Homework and Assignments: Parents can support their child's learning by providing a conducive environment for homework and assignments, helping them to organize their work, and ensuring that they complete their work on time. They must refrain from completing the assignments themselves.
- 4. **Communication:** Parents are encouraged to communicate regularly with the school, including attending parent-teacher conferences and responding to school communications in a timely manner. A change in the address or telephone number must be informed immediately. Parents are encouraged to utilize the remark column provided at the bottom of each homework grid in the almanac for any communication they may wish to convey to the teacher.
- Discipline: Parents should support the school's efforts to maintain a safe and respectful learning environment by reinforcing the importance of discipline and following the school's disciplinary policies.

- 6. **Health and Safety:** Parents are responsible for ensuring that their child is in good health and able to attend school, and for informing the school of any health or safety concerns. Parents must keep their child at home, if he/she is suffering from any infection or disease. The child should be sent to school, only when he /she is absolutely fine. They are further advised to inform the school in written, if their child is allergic to any of the medicines used for First-Aid in school.
- Valuable items: Parents must not send the child carrying any valuable articles to school.
- Leave and Applications: All applications for leave are to be signed by the parents. No application will be valid without the signature of parents.
- Daily Requirements: The daily requirements (meals, stationery and books etc.) have to be brought to the School by students, No item will be accepted at school gate.
- Involvement: Parents are encouraged to be involved in school activities
 and events, such as volunteering for school committees or attending
 school performances.
- 11. **Respect:** Parents are expected to model respectful behaviour towards the school staff, other parents, and their child's peers, and to promote a culture of respect and cooperation within the school community.
- 12. Birthday Celebrations: In adherence to school guidelines, it is advised that cake cutting for birthday celebrations is not permitted. Additionally, students are discouraged from bringing expensive return

- gifts. Furthermore, teachers should not be obliged with any gifts as per school policy.
- 13. **Visitor record:** To keep surveillance on people entering the school gate, it is mandatory for the parents to fill the visitor record at the entry gate.
- 14. School Attendance and Engagement Guidelines: Children will not be allowed to go home during school hours. Parents are requested not to make any social engagement or medical appointments during working hours. To ensure better discipline, parents should not send children to school on that day.
- 15. **Student Pick-up Protocol and Emergency Procedures:** Students who are escorted home either by a parent/guardian are allowed to be picked up only if the escort carries the Parent's I -Card. No student is allowed to leave the school premises before dispersal time unless there is a medical emergency and the permission has been granted in writing
- 16. The school Face book page and Instagram Handle is an important and an effective medium to get the latest updates about the school activities along with photographs and videos. Parents are requested to browse the site regularly to know about all the happenings of the school, important circulars, accolades gained and events organized.
- 17. Academic and Behavioural Dismissal Policy: The Principal reserves the right to dismiss any pupil who continuously fails to make satisfactory progress in studies or whose conduct is not good.
- 18. **Notification regarding withdrawal:** Students who wish to withdraw from school must notify the appropriate school authority, such as the Principal, Class in-charge. Parents are requested to give one calendar

months' notice in writing, failing which one month's fee will be charged in lieu thereof. Exception may be made in case of sudden transfer of a Government or Military personnel. Those who leave the school in the month of May must, in all cases, pay the fees for the month of June.

19. Examination Notice: Students are advised that examinations will be conducted strictly as per the schedule provided in the examination calendar. Only medical leave will be considered. Requests for rescheduling due to personal events such as weddings or any other non-medical reasons will not be entertained. It is urged that parents plan personal events accordingly to align with the examination schedule. No exams will be conducted on dates other than those specified in the official examination schedule.



SCHOOL RULES FOR STUDENTS

- 1. **Attendance:** Students are expected to attend school regularly and arrive on time. Latecomers may face disciplinary action.
- Dress Code: Students must adhere to the school's dress code policy, which may include wearing a uniform or house dress.
- 3. **Almanac:** Every student should carry his almanac to school every day and wear his/her identity card.
- 4. **Behaviour:** Students are expected to behave in a respectful and responsible manner, treating others with kindness and avoiding any form of harassment or bullying.
- Safety and Security: Students must follow safety guidelines, such as
 wearing appropriate protective gear during practical sessions, and
 must report any safety or security concerns to the appropriate
 authority.
- 6. **Homework and Assignments:** Students are expected to complete all assignments and homework on time, and to submit them to the teacher in the required format.
- 7. **Stay mindful:** Switch off all the lights and fans before leaving your classroom and changing classrooms between periods should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.
- 8. **Class Pass:** Do not come out of your class without permission and class pass.

- School property: Care must be taken of the school property and facilities. No student should scratch or spoil the desks or damage school furniture. Students are expected to report any damage or misuse.
- Academic Integrity: Students must uphold academic integrity and avoid cheating or plagiarism. A student who uses unfair means during test will be given zero in the subject and warning letter will be issued.
- 11. **Discipline:** Suitable corrective action will be taken against late comers, uniform defaulters, undisciplined children and those who do not do their homework regularly.
- 12. **Language:** Except in Language classes, only English must be spoken in the school. The parents should also converse with children in English so that proper interaction continues.
- 13. **School Uniform:** Students are required to wear the proper school uniform neatly on all working days and are not to wear items that deviate from the uniform listed in the Almanac.
- 14. All boys (except Sikhs) must wear their hair short in a proper simple manner. They cannot have their hair shelved into patterns. Girls who have very short hair must pinned them up and those with shoulder-length hair should tie them back in one or two braids. Girl must wear only small earrings.
- 15. At the conclusion of the academic year, all 10th-grade students are required to complete and submit a 'No Due' form, ensuring that all outstanding obligations, including library books, canteen bills, and other relevant clearances, have been duly addressed.

Instructions Pertaining To Payment of School Fee

SCHEDULE OF PAYMENT

1. Fee for the whole term is charged in four instalments.

First quarter: April –June
 Second quarter: July-Sept
 Third quarter: Oct-Dec
 Fourth quarter: Jan-March
 The fee to be paid by 15th July
 The fee to be paid by 15th Oct
 The fee to be paid by 15th Jan

2. If the 15th of a month is a Sunday or Holiday, the next working day will be the last day.

Consequences of Non-Payment:

A Late fee fine will be charged as under:

- For first month of quarter For eg: 16th April to 30th April- Rs 50 per week.
- · For second month of quarter-Rs 100 per week
- · For third month of quarter-Rs 100 per week.
- · If Fee is not paid in the quarter, Rs 1000/- will be charged.

Total fee for 12 months can also be paid together to avail the discount

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

- 1. **Safety:** Students are expected to follow all safety rules and guidelines while using school transport, which includes staying seated while the vehicle is in motion, and not distracting the driver.
- 2. Behaviour: Students should behave in a respectful and responsible manner while using school transport, including avoiding any form of harassment or bullying and following the instructions of the driver or other school staff. If a student constantly misbehaves in the bus or is found deliberately damaging bus fitments, he can be debarred from availing of the bus service.
- 3. **Punctuality:** Students should arrive at the designated pickup point on time to avoid delaying the transport and causing inconvenience to others. Parents are requested to see that the students are escorted to and from the bus. The escorts should be at the bus stop ten minutes before the expected arrival of the bus.
- 4. **Routes and Stops:** The school transport will follow specific routes and stops, and students should not request changes to the established route or stops without the prior approval of the school authorities.
- 5. **Damages:** Students will be held responsible for any damage to the school transport or its equipment caused by their behaviour or negligence.
- 6. **Discontinuation of bus service:** A month's notice in writing, is required to discontinue the use of school transport.



RULES CONCERNING WITHDRAWALS

- 1. **Notification:** Students who wish to withdraw from school must notify the appropriate school authority, such as the Principal, Class in-charge. Parents are requested to give one calendar months' notice in writing, failing which one month's fee will be charged in lieu thereof. Exception may be made in case of sudden transfer of a Government or Military personnel. Those who leave the school in the month of May must, in all cases, pay the fees for the month of June.
- 2. **Reason for Withdrawal:** Students may be required to provide a reason for their withdrawal, such as a change of residence or transfer to another school.
- 3. Withdrawal Procedure: Students may need to follow a specific withdrawal procedure, such as returning textbooks or other school property, clearing any outstanding balances. All dues must be settled and cleared. A Transfer Certificate will be issued only when the child produces a clearance certificate that NO DUES stand against him/her.
- 4. **Record Keeping:** The school should maintain accurate records of student withdrawals, including the reason for withdrawal, the date of withdrawal, and any relevant information related to the student's academic progress.
