PROTOCOLS TO FOLLOW

GUIDELINES TO PARENTS

1. **Profile Form:** The student's profile form printed in the school almanac must be filled accurately and submitted promptly.
2. **Attendance:** Parents must ensure regular and punctual attendance. In case of absence, the school must be informed.
3. **Homework & Assignments:** Parents should provide a supportive environment for completing homework. However, they must refrain from completing assignments on behalf of their child.
4. **Communication:** Parents are encouraged to attend PTMs and respond to school communications promptly. Any change in address or contact number must be informed immediately in writing.
5. **Discipline:** Parents are expected to support the school's disciplinary policies and reinforce respectful behaviour at home.
6. **Health & Safety:** Parents must ensure that their child is in good health before sending them to school. If a child is suffering from any infectious disease, they must remain at home until fully recovered. Parents are also required to inform the school in writing if their child is allergic to any medicine.
7. **Valuables:** Students must not bring valuable articles to school.
8. **Leave Applications:** All leave applications must be signed by parents.
9. **Daily Requirements:** Meals, books, and stationery must be brought daily. No items will be accepted at the school gate.
10. **Parent Involvement:** Parents are encouraged to participate in school activities and events.
11. **Respect:** Parents must model respectful behaviour towards staff, students, and other parents.

12. **Birthday Celebrations:** Cake cutting is not permitted in school. Expensive return gifts are discouraged. Teachers must not be presented with gifts.
13. **Visitor Record:** All visitors must sign the visitor register at the school gate.
14. **School Attendance and Engagement Guidelines:** Children will not be permitted to leave the school premises during school hours. Parents are requested not to schedule social engagements or medical appointments during working hours. If unavoidable, the child should remain absent for the day.
15. **Student Pick-up Protocol:** Students may be picked up only by a parent/guardian carrying the Parent ID Card. No student will be allowed to leave before dispersal time except in case of a medical emergency, with written permission from the school authorities.
16. **Social Media Updates:** Parents are encouraged to regularly check the school's official Facebook and Instagram pages for updates and circulars.
17. **Dismissal Policy:** The principal reserves the right to dismiss any student who fails to maintain satisfactory academic progress or good conduct.
18. **Withdrawal Notice:** One calendar month's written notice is required for withdrawal, failing which one month's fee will be charged. Fees for June must be paid by those withdrawing in May.



SCHOOL RULES FOR STUDENTS

1. **Attendance:** Students are expected to attend school regularly and arrive on time. Latecomers may face disciplinary action.
2. **Dress Code:** Students must adhere to the school's dress code policy, which may include wearing a uniform or house dress.
3. **Almanac:** Every student should carry their almanac to school every day and wear his/her identity card.
4. **Behaviour:** Students are expected to behave in a respectful and responsible manner, treating others with kindness and avoiding any form of harassment or bullying.
5. **Safety and Security:** Students must follow safety guidelines, such as wearing appropriate protective gear during practical sessions, and must report any safety or security concerns to the appropriate authority.
6. **Homework and Assignments:** Students are expected to complete all assignments and homework on time, and to submit them to the teacher in the required format.
7. **Stay mindful:** Switch off all the lights and fans before leaving your classroom and changing classrooms between periods should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.
8. **Class Pass:** Do not come out of your class without permission and class pass.
9. **School property:** Care must be taken of the school property and facilities. No student should scratch or spoil the desks or damage school furniture. Students are expected to report any damage or misuse.
10. **Academic Integrity:** Students must uphold academic integrity and refrain from cheating or plagiarism. Any student found using unfair means during a test will receive zero marks in the subject and a warning letter will be issued.
11. **Discipline:** Suitable corrective action will be taken against latecomers, uniform defaulters, undisciplined children and those who do not do their homework regularly.
12. **Language:** Except in Language classes, only English must be spoken in the school. The parents should also converse with children in English so that proper interaction continues.
13. **School Uniform:** Students are required to wear the proper school uniform neatly on all working days and are not to wear items that deviate from the uniform listed in the Almanac.
14. **Grooming Standards:** Boys (except Sikhs) must keep their hair short and neatly trimmed. Hairstyles with patterns or extreme styling are not

permitted. Girls with shoulder-length or longer hair must tie it neatly in one or two braids. Only small earrings are permitted.

15. At the conclusion of the academic year, all 10th-grade students are required to complete and submit a 'No Due' form, ensuring that all outstanding obligations, including library books, canteen bills, and other relevant clearances, have been duly addressed.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

1. **Safety:** Students are expected to follow all safety rules and guidelines while using school transport, which includes staying seated while the vehicle is in motion, and not distracting the driver.
2. **Behaviour:** Students should behave in a respectful and responsible manner while using school transport, including avoiding any form of harassment or bullying and following the instructions of the driver or other school staff. If a student repeatedly misbehaves on the bus or deliberately damages bus property, they may be debarred from availing the bus service.
3. **Punctuality:** Students should arrive at the designated pickup point on time to avoid delaying the transport and causing inconvenience to others. Parents are requested to see that the students are escorted to and from the bus. The escorts should be at the bus stop ten minutes before the expected arrival of the bus.
4. **Routes and Stops:** The school transport will follow specific routes and stops, and students should not request changes to the established route or stops without the prior approval of the school authorities.
5. **Damages:** Students will be held responsible for any damage to the school transport or its equipment caused by their behaviour or negligence.
6. **Discontinuation of bus service:** A one month's written notice is required to discontinue the school transport service.



RULES CONCERNING WITHDRAWALS

- 1. Notification:** Students who wish to withdraw from school must notify the appropriate school authority, such as the Principal, Class in-charge. Parents are requested to give one calendar months' notice in writing, failing which one month's fee will be charged in lieu thereof. Exception may be made in case of sudden transfer of a government or Military personnel. Those who leave the school in the month of May must, in all cases, pay the fees for the month of June.
- 2. Reason for Withdrawal:** Students may be required to provide a reason for their withdrawal, such as a change of residence or transfer to another school.
- 3. Withdrawal Procedure:** Students may need to follow a specific withdrawal procedure, such as returning textbooks or other school property, clearing any outstanding balances. All dues must be settled and cleared. A Transfer Certificate will be issued only when the child produces a clearance certificate that NO DUES stand against him/her.
- 4. Record Keeping:** The school should maintain accurate records of student withdrawals, including the reason for withdrawal, the date of withdrawal, and any relevant information related to the student's academic progress.
